She will attach a copy of your transcript (including first semester 2009-2010 grades) to your application materials and place them in a sealed envelope marked PTSA SCHOLARSHIP in the PTSA mailbox.
- \* A panel of judges will review applications. Applications will be evaluated based on consistent academic performance, Sanderson involvement, community activities, and your essay. Winners of the one-time \$500 scholarships will be notified in May 2010.
